Dan Smith's Note: I built the font so that the vowel signs appear over/under the next consecutive consonent symbol. But when words end with a vowel sound, there is no letter to carry the vowel sign! - so that vowel symbol is left hanging in mid-air. So I can only assume that this alphabet is intended for use with languages where words never end with vowel sounds.
